Key Knowledge

Knowledge and understanding of the past events, people and changes in the past.

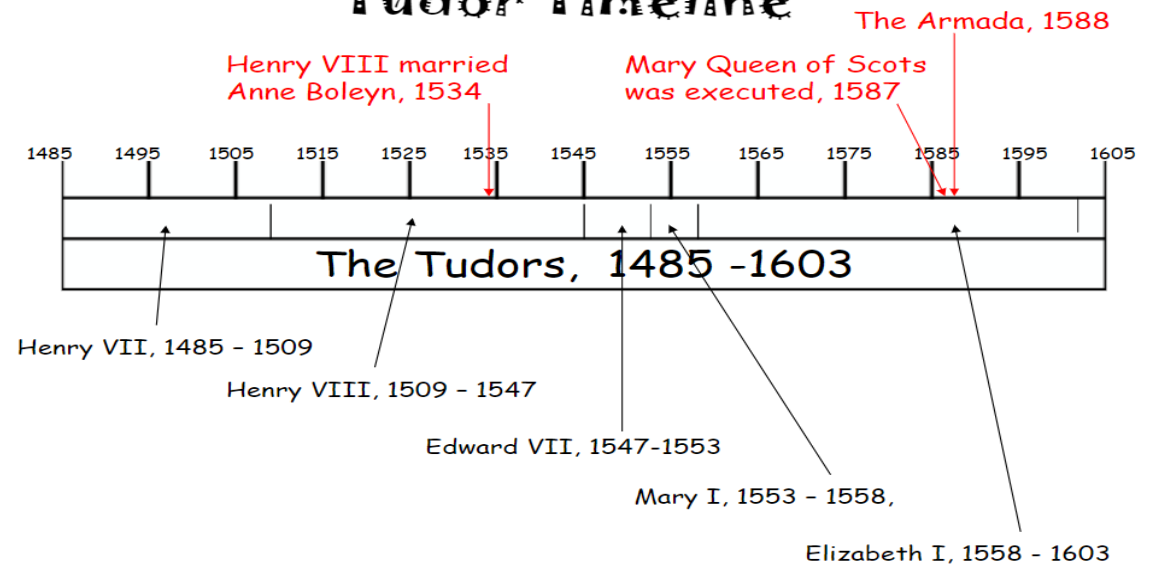
Battle of Bosworth	The last battle in the 'War of the Roses'. Victorious Henry VII deposes Richard III as King of England.
Henry VIII	Perhaps, the most well-known Tudor monarch. He had 6 wives.
Spanish Armada	A naval fleet sent by Spain to invade England in 1588.
Hardwick Hall	An Elizabethan mansion in Derbyshire with huge windows on all sides. It was laughed at for being 'more glass than walls'.
Virginia	An English colony named after Queen Elizabeth II— other colonies were founded by the French, Spanish, Portuguese and Dutch.
Black Death	The Black Death, also known as the Peste and the Plague, was the most fatal pandemic recorded in human history, resulting in the deaths of up to 75–200 million people peaking between from 1347 to 1351.

House of Tudor	The House of Tudor was an English royal house of Welsh origin.
Excommunication	The act of banishing an individual from the Church of Rome.
Invasion	An act of using military force to take over an independent country.
Pottage	A vegetable soup, flavoured with herbs and thickened with oats—an essential food of the Tudor poor.
Age of Discovery	The Age of Discovery or Age of Exploration was a period from the early 15th century that continued into the early 17th century, during which European ships travelled around the World to search for new trading routes and partners.
Plague Doctor	A plague doctor was a someone who treated victims of the Plague—their methods were highly questionable!
