Dear Parents / Carers,

As we enter the month of December, our thoughts turn to our Christmas celebrations. I would like to share some key dates and information with our Carr Head family and look forward to sharing our celebrations with you.

Christmas Raffle: Our PTFA will be selling raffle tickets after school on a Friday starting on Friday 9th December. Watch out for more information about the fantastic prizes that you could win!

Thursday 15th December: Oak / Y1 dress rehearsal for the children in other year groups to watch.

Monday 19th December: We would like to invite the parents/carers of Oak and Year 1 children to watch the children's nativity performance of 'Whoops a Daisy Angel'. The performance will take place at **3.45pm**. No ticket required. So that we can ensure that the children from other year groups are collected at home time safely, we would ask that you do not gather in the car park to await the doors opening until 3.40pm.

Tuesday 20th December: Christmas Jumper Day: We would like to give the children the option to wear a Christmas jumper for the day and for our Christmas event after school. If your child does not already have a Christmas jumper, please do not feel that you have to go out and buy one. Children can wear a piece of tinsel, or a Christmas hat if they prefer, instead of a jumper.

Christingles: The children will be learning all about Christmas in the lead up to the Christmas break. This will include learning about the symbolism of Christingles. All the children will be making a Christingle in school. We would be very grateful if you would please provide an orange and send it into school on Friday 16th December.



Christmas Sing Along / Christingle: We would like to invite you to our Christmas Sing Along / Christingle after school on Tuesday 20th December once you have collected your children and their Christingles at home time. Our PTFA will be selling hot drinks (please bring a lidded cup if you have one) and mince pies in the hall. It is our intention to then gather around the Christmas Tree on our school playground for a Christmas Sing-a-long. This will include lighting the children's Christingles at the end.
